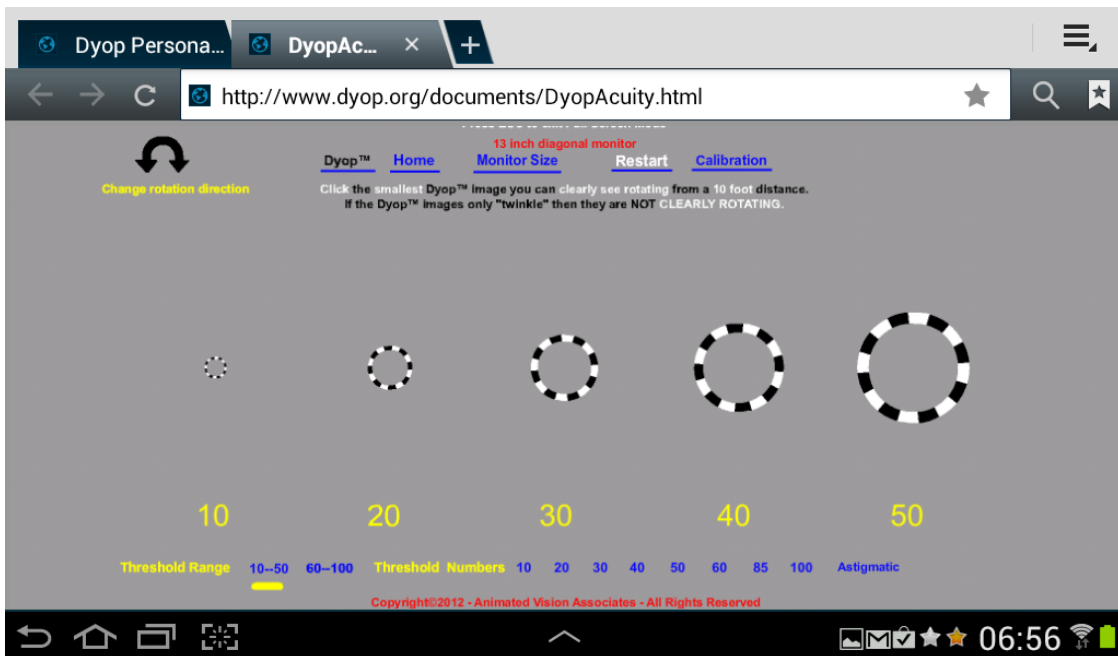
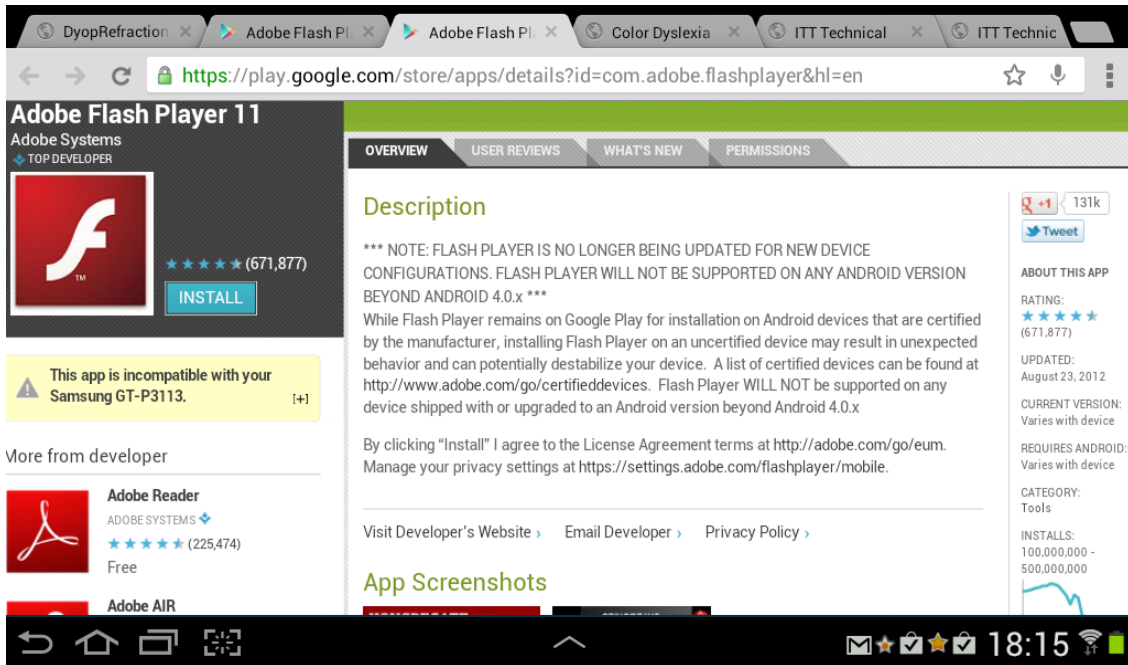


How to enable Adobe Flash Viewer on an Android device

As of August 15, 2012, Google will no longer allow the use of the Adobe Flash Viewer on Android devices. However, there is a work around.

Download the Dolphin Browser on your Tablet at <http://dolphin-browser.com/>. Download the Adobe Flash Viewer using your Dolphin Browser. Using Google Chrome will block the download. You may also want to download the Flash app on a computer and email it to yourself using the Dolphin Browser and Gmail on your Tablet as a You-Sent-It attachment.

Use the Dolphin browser to install the Adobe Flash Viewer as an "Unauthorized" application. To allow app installs from non-Market apps, tap the menu button on your home screen, then choose Settings >> Applications >> Unknown sources. Once the app is installed, it will also run in Google Chrome.



Flash WILL work with your Tablet thanks to the Dolphin browser.
